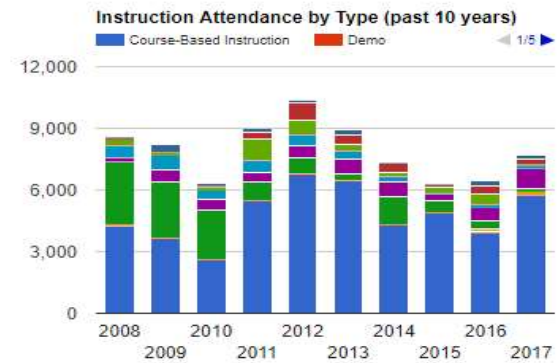
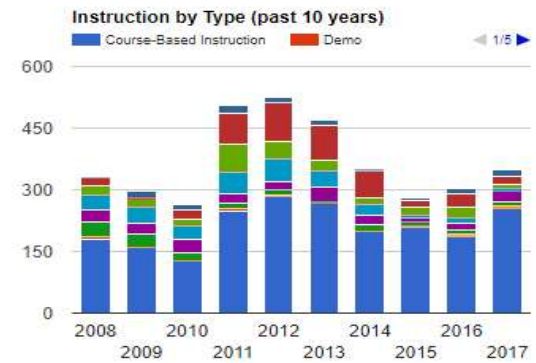
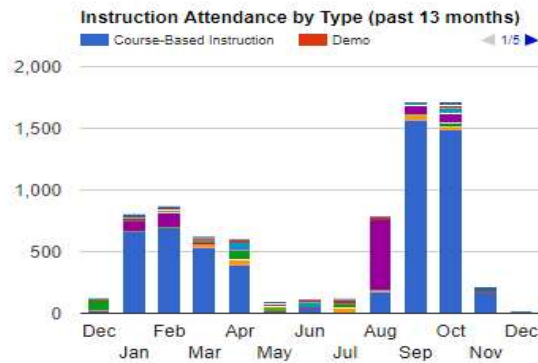
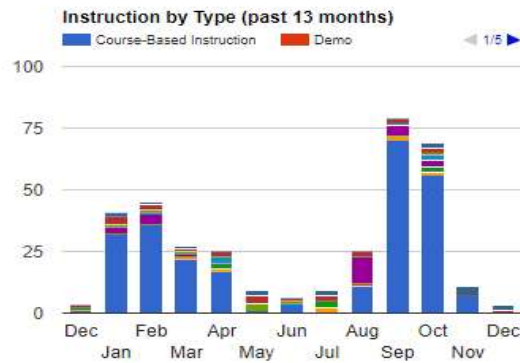
Library Statistics Dashboard: All Transactions Comparison


